Requirements for All

- Minimum of **9 credits** for full-time
- **ENVIRON 896:** Professional Communications (.05 credits)
- **ENVIRON 898:** Master's Project Seminar (1 credit each term)
- **48 credits required to graduate!**
Does not include prerequisite credits, audit, etc.



Flat-rate tuition – open to take as many credits as you wish above the minimum 9 required for full-time

After Sept. 8, withdraw is the only option ★

Cannot enroll in courses that conflict! ★



Course Numbering

(undergrad & grad/prof)



- **100-199 range** intro level undergrad courses; cannot be counted towards their MEM and MF degree or to fulfill program requirements
- **200-499 range** upper level undergrad courses; take up to 2 courses (or 6 credits) in this range to fulfill a general elective not program requirements
- **Undergraduate courses 1 unit = 3 credits for grad/prof**
- **500-699 range** are graduate/professional level classes but upper level undergrads may enroll
- **700 level and above** are open only to grad/prof
- **900 range** for the [Duke Environmental Leadership \(DEL\) Program](#). Online courses; open to DEL only fall; non-DEL in the spring

Inter-Institutional Courses

1. Course registration **form** required
2. Student's **signature** required
3. Academic coursework advisor signature is **not** required
4. **Departmental approval** required; see the NSOE Registrar
5. **If instructor consent is required**, it must be obtained before the form is submitted and processed. Emails are okay
6. Not all courses will require instructor consent to enroll; in fact, **most will not**

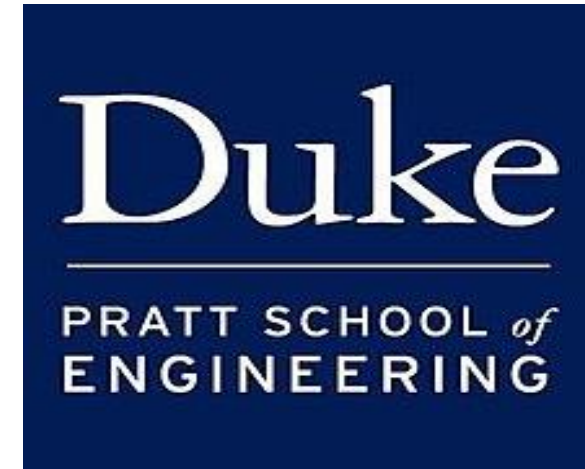
- Courses at the **Duke Law School** and the **Fuqua School of Business** do **NOT** follow the university's academic calendar
- **Fuqua quarter system**
- You should plan to **start classes early** (if necessary) and classes may **continue after your NSOE courses** have concluded

- Submit form to NSOE registrar
- **If space is available**, enrollment will occur right before the start of classes
- Deadline is **September 8**
- >> **Sanford School of Public Policy** enroll directly in Duke (if no restrictions)



Fuqua School of Business

- **If space is available**, enrollment will occur right before the start of Fuqua classes
- Deadline is **Thursday, August 24**

- **Fall 2 Begins** on **Oct 30**; drop/add ends on Oct 31



Audit and Pass/Fail



1. **Enroll in course** in the DukeHub
2. **Request Form** and **Original Instructor signature** required (change in grading basis); **email not allowed**
3. Does count in the **number of credits** you are enrolled in
4. **Cannot** be used towards **grad requirements**
5. Submit to NSOE registrar

Differences:

- **Audit:** Major requirements: **class participation** and **attendance**
- **Pass/Fail:** **All course assignments**, exams, participation etc required

Independent Study



- Discuss the potential for an independent study with a faculty member including **topic**, **scope**, **expectations** and number of **credits**
- Enroll in the instructor's section **ENVIRON 593**
- **Permission number** required to enroll
- Submit independent study [online notification form](#) to get title added to transcript (30 character limit)
- **Graded courses** (standard letter grade)

Waitlist

- If a **class is full**, the [DukeHub](#) will construct a list of students requesting enrollment in the order in which attempts to enroll in the course are logged. The waitlisted **course will count towards** the total course registration limit.
 - **Students can waitlist a class that conflicts with another enrolled class**, however cannot enroll until **time conflict** is resolved.
 - **Caution:** All waitlists with the exception graduate courses at Fuqua, Law, NSOE and Pratt will be erased at the end of the first week of classes.
- ★ During the second week of classes, all undergraduate courses below the 500 level will require a permission number. **Be advised, being on a waitlist for a class does not guarantee eventual enrollment to the class.**



“Make a backup plan!”

Withdraw

- **After drop/add** registration ends on September 8, students wishing to discontinue their enrollment in a course may do so only by **withdrawing** from the course.
- **Course Withdraw Form**; instructor signature
- Submit **NSOE Registrar**
- ➔ • **“W” Grade will remain on your permanent record**
- **Exception:** If the course has not started, the registrar can request a manual drop



Permission Numbers



- **Instructor consent** required – Class attributes in the DukeHub
- Obtain number from **instructor**
- **Permission numbers guarantee your spot in the course**
- Request only those that you **need**
- Ask about the **expiration date**

NSOE Registrar Permission Numbers

Three Exceptions (submit online request form)

1. **ENVIRON 755.01: Ocean Coastal Law and Policy** (Roady); Enrollment priority will go to students in the CEM program area, especially 2nd years.
2. **ENVIRON 835.01: Environmental Law** (Instructor: Wiener); Enrollment priority will go to students in the EEP program area, especially 2nd years.
3. **ENVIRON 710.001: Applied Data Analysis/Statistics** using R and STATA
 - Passing grade on the **statistics diagnostic required**
 - **Permission numbers are attached to the lab sections.** Be prepared to specify **lab** you wish to take. The lecture will automatically be added.

➡ **No permission number requests will be accepted prior to Monday, August 21**

Program Changes

- Students may request a change to their program area of study up until the **end of the first year of enrollment**
- Submit **Program Change Request Form**
- Refer to the list of required and recommended **program prerequisites** for the new program area
- Program Chair must **sign** the form and **assign new academic advisor**

Add Master of Forestry or Master of Environmental Management

- Submit **Program Add**
- See Program Chair for **signature** and **new advisor**



DEL-MEMs

1. NSOE courses numbered **900 and above** are reserved for DEL-MEM students only in the fall.

2. New students must enroll in ***all*** of these courses in the fall fall.

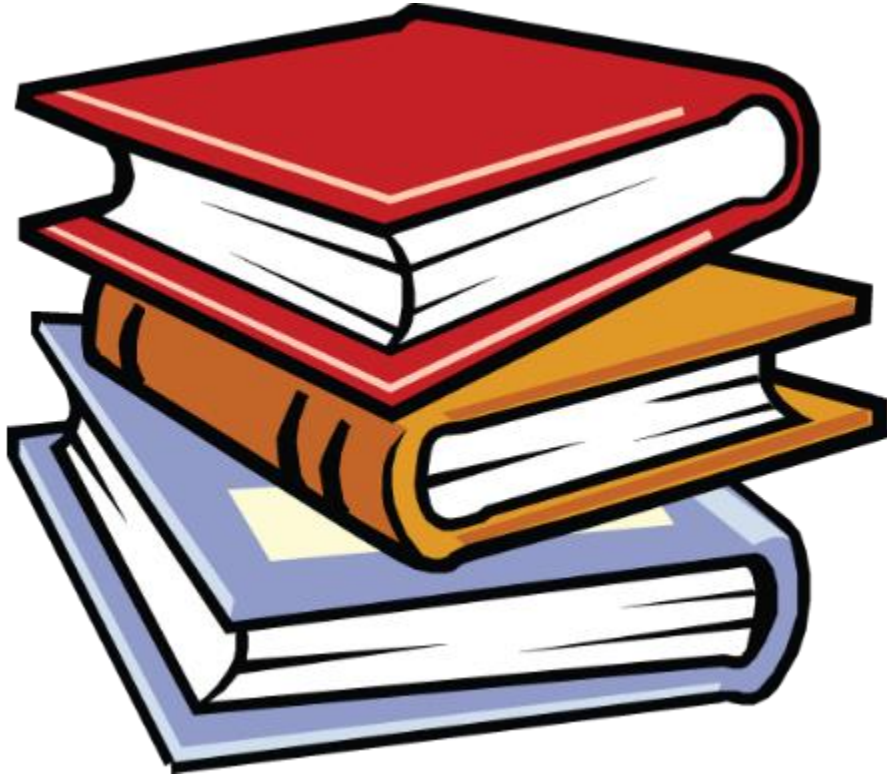

3. This may seem like a lot of classes but **ENV 998 MP Seminar** do not be alarmed. Both ENV **966 Professional Writing** and are only **one credit courses** and ENV 998 will only meet approximately 3-4 times in the fall.

4. All new **DEL-MEM students** should be enrolled in **10 credits this fall**. Reminder, a minimum of 30 total credits are required for graduation.
